Safety Induction Checklist

This form is designed as an aid for familiarising personnel with the safety features and procedures on board this vessel.*

ALL new employees and those unfamiliar with the vessel should participate in the **Safety Induction** activity below.

This induction is to be conducted by the skipper of the vessel or authorised qualified person.

[✓] No's 1 to 16: All Vessels

1. [] Job duties explained (*including safe work practices e.g., securing loose items, fishing operations, lookout duties, correct lifting of heavy weights etc*)
2. [] Workplace hazards and dangers (*winches, chains, cables, hot surfaces, slippery surfaces etc*)
3. [] Life jacket (*personal flotation devices*) locations and donning demonstration
4. [] Operation of ship's VHF/HF radio and communication equipment (*including EPIRBs*)
5. [] Pyrotechnics (*flares*) and line throwing apparatus (*description & instruction*)
6. [] Emergency fuel shutoffs, ventilation fire flaps and dampers (*location & operation*)
7. [] Location of emergency torches
8. [] Fire extinguishers (*including types*) and spaces served by smothering systems (*location & operation*)
9. [] Basic fire fighting instruction
10. [] Location of Medical Locker and/or First Aid kits
11. [] Seasickness (*precautions/remedies to take*)
12. [] Brief outline of emergency drills: (*man overboard, accident casualty, watertight doors, fire, radio distress calls, vessel grounding, abandon vessel etc*)

13. [] Anchor deployment instruction
14. [] Life raft and rescue boat locations (*with launching instructions & procedures*)
15. [] Safety on deck at night
16. [] Safety procedures in tenders or dinghy's

[✓] No's 17 to 28 where appropriate for vessel

17. [] Life buoy locations and use
18. [] Operation of fire and/or emergency alarms
19. [] Escape routes from accommodation
20. [] Fire hydrants and hoses (*location & operation*)
21. [] Location and operation of emergency fire pump
22. [] Location and operation of emergency bilge pump
23. [] Escape routes from machinery spaces
24. [] Galley fan stops, gas isolator and fire blanket
25. [] Location and use of personal protective equipment (*ear defenders, safety glasses, safety helmet etc*)
26. [] Mooring Procedure
27. [] Other safety equipment i.e. immersion suit, stretcher, personal EPIRB, safety harness etc.
28. [] Location of Muster Area
